Vinod Patel's research focuses on insulin and the prevention of diabetic complications. His Diabetes Care Team was instrumental in developing the "Alphabet Strategy" for patient-centred, evidence-based, multi-professional diabetes care. This preventative and treatment-oriented strategy has been presented in over 30 countries.

James Collip was the first head of the Department of Biochemistry and was recognized by Royal Society of Canada and Canada Order of Excellence awards for purifying insulin, which transformed clinical care and led to a global insulin market of \$30 billion.
